The Board resumed its session, Niland and Salisbury present, Orton absent.

A motion was made by Salisbury and seconded whereby the following resolution was adopted to wit:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it is no longer in the public interest to maintain a certain portion of the old Wyoming Highway Department Highway No. 130-230, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3, Title 24, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, provides for statutory vacation of county highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that statutory proceedings for the vacation of old Wyoming Highway Department Highway No. 130-230 in Section Five (5), Eight (8), Nine (9) and Sixteen (16), County, Wyoming, be, and they are hereby initiated and the County and Prosecuting Attorney, Carbon County, Wyoming, is hereby authorized to do any and all things necessary in the premised to effect vacation of said county highway as by law provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Notice of Vacation be published in The Rawlins Daily Times on November 16, 23, 30, 1968, a copy of said notice being attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all objections to the vacation of said road and claims for damages by reason thereof, shall be filed with the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming, on or before noon on the 8th day of January, 1969.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that objections or claims for damages not so filed shall be disregarded, not considered and shall be deemed to have been waived and barred.

NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT OF PUBLIC ROAD

TO ALL TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners has decided to vacate and abandon a certain portion of the old Wyoming Highway Department Highway No. 130-230, described as follows:

All that portion of Section 16, T. 16 N., R. 83 W., 6th P. M., Carbon County, Wyoming, lying between parallel right-of-way lines 80 feet apart, being 40 feet on each side of the following described centerline of road:

Beginning at a point which bears S 76° 19' W., a distance of 2511.06 ± feet from the W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 16, said Township & Range, said point being the intersection of said centerline of road, and the centerline of a right-of-way accomodating the existing Wyoming Highway Department Highway No. S-0103 (2) and Wyo. 130 at station 31 + 87.10;

thence, S 26° 10' E., a distance of 2086.8 ± feet to the point of beginning of a 15° 00' curve to the right; through a central angle of 52° 40', along a radius of 382 feet, a distance of 351.1 feet to the point of ending of said curve;

thence, S 26° 30' W., a distance of 375.6 ± feet to a point of intersection with the South section line of said Section 16, said Township and Range.

The above described right-of-way is 0.533 miles in length, and contains approximately 5.167 acres.

All that portion of Sections 5, 8, 9 and 16, T. 16 N., R. 83 W., 6th P. M., Carbon County, Wyoming, lying between parallel right-of-way lines 80 feet apart being 40 feet on each side when measured at right angles of radially to the following described centerline of road;

Beginning at a point which is an intersection of the heretofore mentioned centerline of road, and the centerline of a recently constructed highway (Wyo. 130-230 Wyo. Project No. F-022-1 (4) said point bears N.  $7^{\circ} 55'$  W., a distance of 4004.16 ± feet from the South  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 5, said Township and Range.

thence, S  $42^{\circ} 38'$  E., a distance of 752.19' ± to the point of beginning of a  $2^{\circ} 00'$  circular curve to the right;

thence, along a radius of 2864.8 feet through a central angle of  $16^{\circ} 28'$ , a distance of 823.3 feet to the point of ending of said curve;

thence, S  $26^{\circ} 10'$  E., a distance of 10,958.30 ± feet to the point of termination of said centerline of road, said point being an intersection of said centerline of road, and the centerline of an existing recently constructed highway (Wyo. Highway 130-Wyo. Project No. S-0103 (2) ) said point bears N.  $76^{\circ} 19'$  E., a distance of 2511.06 ± feet from the West  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 16, said Township and Range.

Said portion of land contains approximately 23.019 acres, and is approximately 2.374 miles in length.

The location of the road to be abandoned is set forth in detail on a map on file with County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

All objections thereto or claims for damages by reason of the vacation and abandonment of said road must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said County before noon on the 8th day of January, 1969, or such road will be abandoned, vacated and closed, without reference to such objections or claims.
