TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM CASH RESERVE AND SURPLUS BUDGETS.

In compliance with Art. 3 Sec. 9-535 of Municipal Budget Act, W. S. 1957, a Notice of Hearing on the proposed transfer of funds from the cash reserve was advertised on June 9, and supplemented on June 26, 1972 as follows:  
 County Commissioners \$200.00 County Clerk \$2400.00 County Sheriff \$3700.00 Attorney \$300.00  
 District Court \$1400.00 Justice Court \$200.00 Courthouse & Jail \$1500.00 Elections \$1000.00  
 Road & Bridge Dep't \$5200.00. The Board also decided to transfer \$5000.00 from the Road & Bridge Depreciation Fund to the R & B Fund. County Assessor \$850.00, Sheriff \$400.00 and Road and Bridge \$3000.00 from Surveyor and Health Office budgets.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the above budgets have become depleted due to unanticipated costs,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the County Budget Officer and County Treasurer be authorized to transfer the above mentioned funds.

DEEP CREEK ROAD I R 617. The Board of Commissioners agreed to charge and cost incurred in excess of \$400.000.00 on above mentioned road, to SC-CFM 6-16.

SPECIAL MUSEUM DISTRICT:

A petition signed by property owners representing twenty-five (25%) or more of the assessed valuation of property within the following described areas, petitioning the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming to establish a special museum district and which district shall be known as SAVERY MUSEUM DISTRICT, and which district shall be composed of the following described lands bounded as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Township 12 North Range 87 West which point is the Wyoming-Colorado boundary; Thence, North along range line between ranges 86 West and 87 West to the Northeast corner of Township 16 North Range 87 West; Thence, west along the Township line between Townships 16 and 17 North to the Southeast corner of Township 17 North Range 91 West; Thence, North along Range line between Ranges 90 West and 91 West to the Sweetwater County line; Thence, West along the Carbon-Sweetwater County line to the northwest corner of Township 19 North Range 93 West (The Northwesterly corner of Carbon County, Wyoming;) Thence, South along the Carbon-Sweetwater line to the Wyoming-Colorado State line; thence, East the Wyoming-Colorado State line to the place of beginning.

Within 90 days after this petition is filed with the Board of County Commissioners, Carbon County, Wyoming, we request said Board to hold a public hearing, at which hearing any person may appear and shall be heard concerning and all matters affecting the creation of such special museum district.
