COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING

The Commissioners met at 2:00 P.M. All members present, John Niland, Chairman, to attend to several County matters, also to hear all persons relative to the 1972-1973 budget requests, this meeting to be held at 8:00 PM.

McFadden-Arlington Road-Project SC-CFM 6-13. A motion was made by Orton, seconded by McMillen and carried wherev the following resolution was adopted, to wit:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, deem the publicinterest requires that a road be established to be known as the McFadden-Arlington Road, Project SC-CFM 6-13, described as follows:

Commencing at a point in Lot 4 of Section 31, T.20N., R.77 W. of the 6th P.M., Wyoming, which point bears S.72° 25.3' E. a distance of 758.8 feet from a point on the west boundary of said Section 31 from which the southwest corner thereof bears S.)° 12' E. a distance of 418.8 feet; Tence running southwesterly a distance of approximately 7.7 miles through Section 31, T.20N., R 77W., Section 36, T. 20N., R. 78W., and Sections 1,2,3,10, 9,16,17,18 and 19, T.19N., T.78W., all of the 6th P.M., Wyoming.

To a point of ending on the northerly boundary of the presently existing county road right of way described in Book 511 at page 518 of Miscellaneous Records of Carbon County adjacent to the Interstate Highway 80 Arlington Interchange.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the said Board do hereby initiate the procedure for the establishment of said road, and declare their intention to establish said road by following out the provisions of Section 24-43, Wyoming Statutes 1957, not inconsistent therewith.

NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

Project No. SC-CFM 6-13
Carbon County.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming have decided to locate a road to be known as McFadden - Arlington Road as described in the above resolution.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on a map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

Any landowner or interested party desiring to raise any question with respect to the necessity of the taking of the land for road purposes shall do so by filing, within thirty days after the last publication of this notice, a petition in the District Court of the county in which the land is located. If no petition to raise the question of necessity if filed within the said thirty day period, the necessity shall be presumed and the question cannot later be raised.

All other objections thereto or claims for damages by reason thereof must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said county before noon on the 14 day of August, A.D., 1972, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.
