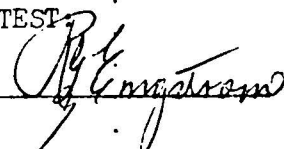
Jan. 3, 1973 The Board resumed its session, all members present, Niland Chairman.
