REGULAR MEETING

The Board met at 10:00 A. M.

MINUTES OF MEETINGS HELD Mar. 5 and 6, 1974 were read and approved.

HOUSING AUTHORITY: A motion was made by McMillen, seconded by Orton and carried whereby the following resolution entitled "A Resolution declaring the need for a Housing Authority to function in Carbon Co. Wyo." was adopted, to wit:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is unsanitary, unsafe, and substandard inhabited dwelling accommodation in Carbon County; and

WHEREAS, there is a shortage of safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations in Carbon County available to persons of low income at rentals or prices they can afford; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that:

The County of Carbon, Wyoming, herein exercises those housing powers authorized by Section 24, 1-2 and 24, 1-16 of Wyoming Statutes; and that

All prior resolutions of the Board that are in conflict with this authorization are repealed and void.

The motion to adopt the resolution was seconded by Mr. Orton, and upon roll call the following voted:

Thereupon the Chairman declared said resolution duly adopted and passed, and signed the same in approval thereof.
