ADDENDUM

THIS ADDENDUM made and entered into this 4 day of Feb., 1975, by and between the COUNTY OF CARBON, STATE OF WYOMING, and JOHN A. MACPHERSON and T. MICHAEL GOLDEN, doing business as Brimmer, MacPherson & Golden,

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H :

WHEREAS the parties hereto have previously entered into a contract relating to the representation of indigent individuals charged with crimes within the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, which contract included the name of C. L. Bates; and

WHEREAS C. L. Bates has accepted an appointment as Deputy County Attorney in and for the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, and such position would be inconsistent with the previous written contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained and other good and valuable consideration passing between the parties, the adequacy and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, it is agreed as follows:

1. That the original contract by and between the parties hereto be, and it is hereby amended to provide that C. L. Bates is no longer a party to such contract and he is hereby relieved of any and all responsibility from performing the duties provided for therein and the County is relieved from making further payments to him.

2. That the firm of Brimmer, MacPherson & Golden shall succeed to any and all interest held by C. L. Bates under the aforementioned contract and that all payments made and provided for therein shall be made to Brimmer, MacPherson & Golden and that firm shall be responsible to perform all the terms and conditions thereof.

BONDS: Bonds as follows were approved: Charles L. Bates, Deputy County Attorney, Carbon County, January 15, 1975 to January 15, 1979, in the amount of \$2000.00.

The Board resumed its session, Niland, Orton and Glode present.

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSES OFFICE: A carpeting bid was let to Rasmussen Furniture for \$2457.25. Two letters were sent to the chairmen of the Senate and House Chambers requesting the funding of one-half of the salary for an additional Public Health Nurse beginning July 1, 1975.

JUSTICE COURT: Secretarial help was approved for the office of Justice of the Peace.

DEPUTY COUNTY CLERK: The Board confirmed the appointment of Lillian Newell as first deputy.

February 5, 1975

RAWLINS-CARBON COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION. An agreement was signed, commencing February 5, 1975, and terminating June 30, 1975, by and between the Rawlins-Carbon County Planning Commission and HNB Consulting Engineers wherein HNB agreed to perform the following duties for the sum of \$14,500.00:

1. Be available a minimum of two days each week in Carbon County.
2. Work with the Planning Commission to provide for an ongoing planning program.
3. Conduct studies outlined in the Comprehensive Planning Program.
4. Attend meetings.
5. Provide liaison with State agencies.
6. Submit briefly written monthly progress reports.
7. Submit necessary documents to continue program during the fiscal year, 1976.

The agreement was placed on file.

AIRPORT MASTER PLAN PAYMENT AGREEMENT. An agreement dated February 5, 1975, setting up the method by which the County will pay one-half of the local share (\$3200.00) of the cost of preparing an airport master plan for the Rawlins Municipal Airport, was also approved and placed on file. The City also will pay \$3200.00 to HNB for this service, and will remit both the city and county shares to HNB.

AGREEMENT FOR PROPOSAL FOR ENGINEERING AND PLANNING SERVICES FOR THE FORMATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF AN AIRPORT MASTER PLAN. An agreement made February 5, 1975, by the Rawlins Airport Board acting by and through the Mayor of the City of Rawlins and the Chairman of the County Commissioners of Carbon County and HNB Consulting Engineers was approved and placed on file. The agreement described the Federal grants and the way in which they are matched and the engineering and planning services to be furnished by HNB.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
