

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING

March 24, 1975

The Board met at 10:00 A.M., for a pre-hearing conference, Niland and Orton present; Niland, Chairman. ^{ROAD}
O R D E R

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, a body politic and corporate are lawfully convened in a special meeting in the Commissioners Chambers, Courthouse Bldg., Rawlins, this 24th day of March, 1975; and

WHEREAS, a request for establishment of a public road known as the Walcott Junction-Peterson Ranch Road has been made to said Board by Elmer G. Peterson; and

WHEREAS, the written consent of all the owners of land to be used for the establishment of said road have been filed in the office of the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming pursuant to Section 24-50, Wyoming Statutes, 1957; and

WHEREAS, said road has heretofore been used for many years by the general public; and

WHEREAS, access to U. S. Highway Interstate 80 is needed from said proposed Walcott Junction-Peterson Ranch Road and connecting with old U. S. Highway 30; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, does find that said road is of sufficient importance to be opened and traveled; and

WHEREAS, said right-of-way for said road should be established with a width of sixty-six (66') and two and three-fourths (2 3/4) miles in length, commencing in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 21 North, Range 83 West of the 6th P. M. and thence northwesterly and westerly through Section 31, Township 21 North, Range 83 West and Section 36, Township 21 North, Range 84 West and terminating in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 21 North, Range 84 West of the 6th P.M., Carbon County, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds and orders that said public road should be ordered established pursuant to Section 24-50, Wyoming Statutes, 1957.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Walcott Junction-Peterson Ranch Road be, and the same is hereby ordered established pursuant to Section 24-50, Wyoming Statutes, 1957.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said road is established in Carbon County, Wyoming with a width of sixty-six feet (66') and two and three-fourths (2 3/4) miles in length, commencing in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 21 North, Range 83 West of the 6th P.M. and thence northwesterly and westerly through Section 31, Township 21 North, Range 83 West and Section 36, Township 21 North, Range 84 West and terminating in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 21 North, Range 84 West of the 6th P.M., Carbon County, Wyoming.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the County Engineer of Carbon County, Wyoming, cause an official plat of said road to be made a matter of public record in the official County and Public Road books of the said Carbon County, Wyoming.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming, be, and she is hereby ordered to officially record a certified copy of this Order in the Land Record books of her office and assign an instrument number and book and page number to the said certified copy of Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall be spread at large upon the official minutes of the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming of this meeting.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the County Clerk be, and she is hereby ordered to forward a certified copy of this Order to:
