COMPOSITION OF BOARD


The Board shall consist of five (5) members, all of whom shall be qualified electors of Carbon County. The initial Board shall be comprised of those individuals presently serving on the City Airport Board with terms expiring as follows:

Joe P. Huner	First Monday in February, 1977
J. A. Zwierzycki	First Monday in February, 1978
Dwight H. France	First Monday in February, 1979
Sam Kelly, Jr.	First Monday in February, 1980
Kermit C. Brown	First Monday in February, 1981

Thereafter appointments for a full term of five years shall be made alternately by the city and county governing bodies during their January meeting of each year, it being agreed that the County shall proceed first in the alternating schedule by appointing a full term member during its January, 1977 meeting, then the City during its January, 1978 meeting, ad infinitum. Vacancies for unexpired terms shall be filled by appointment of the governing bodies of the City and County acting jointly and the appointee so selected shall serve the remaining term of his predecessor so as not to disturb the alternating appointment schedule set forth hereinabove. Members of the Board may be removed for cause by the joint action of the City and County. A full, true and complete copy of the Rawlins-Carbon County Airport Board City-County Agreement is on file in the office of the County Clerk.

#### PHYSICIAN RECRUITING

Gerald W. Bibo, Administrator for the Carbon County Memorial Hospital presented a proposal recommended by the Hospital Board of Trustees for recruiting physicians to help alleviate the physician shortage problem in Rawlins and Carbon County. If funds are available, the Commissioners agreed on the following proposals:

1. Recruiting tools to be made available from the County, to assist independant practitioners in relocating to Rawlins on a long term basis. Such aides as the following will be made available to new physicians seeking to commence practice in Rawlins and Carbon County:
  - a. Moving expenses.
  - b. Malpractice insurance coverage.
  - c. Guarantee of gross income per annum of \$40,000.
  - d. Some consideration toward office start-up assistance.
2. One-half of the cost of malpractice insurance coverage will be offered to practicing physicians as some recognition for service, inconvenience and risk in covering the communities' emergencies.
3. Commence immediately to get Dr. Cashman back into active practice and to recruit another orthopedic surgeon to come into the community, work with Dr. Cashman to serve Rawlins and vicinity 24 hours a day - 7 days a week. Malpractice insurance will be provided for one year paid on a quarterly basis if Dr. Cashman practices only locally or pay half of his malpractice insurance costs if he practices both locally and in Rock Springs.
4. Commence immediately to acquire and/or assist in acquiring a minimum of 2 additional physicians (G.P. and Internist); and G.P. General Surgeon (Dr. Abbas Yazdi has been recruited for the position of G.P. and General Surgeon).

The recruiting tools were approved specifically for two physicians, Dr. Abbas Yazdi, G.P. and General Surgeon and Dr. Monireh Mahboubi a Board Certified Pediatrician.

The above proposals are for one year period with a review of the program at the end of this period.

BIDS FOR TWO 1977 DUMP TRUCKS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE.


