COMMISSIONER'S PROCEEDINGS  
BUDGET HEARING

The Board of Commissioners met at 8:00 P.M., Robert Grieve, Emil T. Lemich and Martin McMahon present; Grieve, Ghairman, to hear all persons relative to the 1980-1981 budget requests.

Persons heard relative to budget requests were Bess Sheller, County Library; Jean Lambertson, Museum Board; Family Planning, Patty Hardzog and Gail Mehle; Carbon County Counseling Center, Margaret Kelly; County Sheriff, George Aydelott; The requests were taken under advisement until the following day.

The Board resumed its session, all members present, Robert Grieve, Chairman.

A motion was made by McMahon to adopt the appropriation resolution. The motion was seconded by Lemich. Roll was called with the following results; Grieve-aye, McMahon-aye, Lemich-aye. The following resolution was adopted, to-wit;

APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of May, 1980, Mary G. Bradford, Carbon County Clerk, the budget making authority, prepared and submitted to the Board a county budget for the 1980-1981 fiscal year ending June 30, 1981.

WHEREAS, such a budget was duly entered at large upon the records of this Board and a copy thereof was made available for public inspection at the Office of the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on such budget, together with the summary of said budget, was published in the Rawlins Daily Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the County on the 4th day of July, 1980 and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on such budget at the time and place specified in said notice, at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the county budget, as so revised and altered, be adopted as the official county budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1981.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following appropriations be made for the 1980-1981 fiscal year ending June 30, 1981 and that the expenditures of each officer, department or spending agency be limited to the amount herein appropriated.

#### SPECIAL MEETING

The Commissioners met at 10:00 o'clock A.M.. Robert Grieve, present; Martin McMahon, present; Emil T. Lemich, present; Robert Grieve, Chairman.

A motion was made by McMahon and seconded by Lemich to adopt the following Resolution:

#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Wyoming Attorney General has issued an opinion which provides that appointments to the positions of Justices of the Peace shall be valid only until the next general election; and,

WHEREAS, the Wyoming Legislature has deleted the requirement that the Justices of the Peace be qualified to practice law in the State of Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, there has existed ambiguity in the past concerning what portions of the county will vote for which Justice of the Peace position or positions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, that all qualified electors of Carbon County, Wyoming, vote on each of the Justice of the Peace positions in Carbon County, Wyoming.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the requirement that the Justices of the Peace in Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming be qualified to practice law is hereby eliminated in accordance with the state statutes.
