WYOMING HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT - County Road 291

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into on this 10th day of January, 1980, by and between the Wyoming State Highway Department, hereinafter referred to as the DEPARTMENT and the Carbon Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the Board.

WHEREAS, the Board desires to take advantage of the provisions of Sections 219 (SOS), 144 (Bridge), 203 (Railway Crossings), Title 23 United States Code and Sections 24-2-110, 24-4-101 (SC-CFM), 24-5-101 (IR), Wyoming Statutes by cooperating with the DEPARTMENT in a local road project.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The proposed project will involve preliminary engineering for survey and plan preparation and construction involving the replacement of the existing structure over the Medicine Bow River located on County Road 6-291 in Sec. 34, T-24N, R-81W.
2. The DEPARTMENT will prepare plans, specifications, and final cost estimates, and will award a construction contract to the lowest qualified bidder. Final design, plans and cost estimates will be concurred in by the Board prior to advertising. All construction work will be under the control of the DEPARTMENT in accordance with the project plans and specifications.
3. The estimated project cost is approximately \$439,200 to be funded as follows:

The Board will reimburse the DEPARTMENT for its participating share within thirty (30) days after being billed by the DEPARTMENT.

4. Should the Board abandon the project prior to advertising for bids, the Board shall reimburse the DEPARTMENT for all expenses of surveys and preparing project plans and documents.
5. Acquisition of right-of-way and utility adjustments required for the project will be the responsibility of the Board. The Board agrees to follow the policies set forth in the Wyoming Relocation Assistance Act of 1973, Section 9-729 through 9-750 in the acquisition of right-of-way required for the project to be constructed under this agreement.
6. The Board shall maintain the project at its own expense after the project has been accepted by the DEPARTMENT. Maintenance shall include all repairs necessary to keep the improvements at its original standard, as constructed.

WHEREAS, This Board deems it necessary and advisable to adopt these Subdivision Regulations for the purpose of promoting and protecting the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Carbon County, Wyoming, by establishing minimum standards for the design and development of subdivisions,

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, at its meeting held on the 4th day of March, 1980, that these, "Subdivision Regulations of Carbon County, Wyoming," as amended, be and the same hereby adopted and shall be effective March 5, 1980.

Be it further resolved that all existing or previously adopted subdivision regulations for Carbon County, Wyoming be and the same are repealed and superseded by these "Subdivision Regulations of Carbon County, Wyoming."

WYOMING HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

TOWN OF HANNA RECLAMATION

A motion was made by Lemich and seconded by McMahon to approve the following Lease Agreement:

LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into to be effective the 5th day of March, 1980, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "Lessor" and the TOWN OF MEDICINE BOW, a Wyoming municipal corporation situate in Carbon County, Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as "Lessee"

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H

WHEREAS the Lessor is the owner of an interest in certain real property hereinafter described rendered largely useless in its present state because of subsidence from an abandoned underground mine, the accumulation of surface water in portions of the property which has subsided and the accumulation of large volumes of refuse and trash deposited on the property by persons unknown over the years; and

WHEREAS the Lessor is a government agency capable of qualifying for financial assistance under the Rural Abandoned Mine Program, hereinafter referred to as "RAMP" for the rehabilitation of areas suffering from subsidence and reclamation through a sanitary landfill program all of which would ultimately benefit and reclaim the real property owned by the Lessor and more particularly described hereinafter; and

WHEREAS the Lessor is willing to lease the property to the Lessee for use as a sanitary landfill and reclamation under the RAMP program provided the Lessor is wholly indemnified and held harmless from any and all costs, judgments or other liabilities which may accrue thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants and representations of the parties each to the other, it is agreed as follows:

1. The Lessor hereby leases to the Lessee, and the Lessee leases from the Lessor subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, all Lessor's right, title and interest in and to real property situate in Carbon County, Wyoming, described as follows:

N1/2 SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, T22N, R81W, of the 6th P.M., Carbon County, Wyoming.

2. The term of this lease shall be ten (10) years from and after the effective date set forth hereinabove.

3. The Lessee shall proceed with reclamation of the land and restoration as wildlife habitat under a Rural Abandoned Mine Program authorized under Title IV of the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977, Public Law No. 95-87, 91 Stat. 460 (30 U.S.C. 1236) to be administered in accordance with the regulations contained in 40 CFR, parts 872 through 888, said program to be administered through the Soil Conservation Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture (SCS) pursuant to the authority contained in 7 CFR 2.62 (a)(9) and 7 CFR 632. Inability of the Lessee to implement a RAMP program on the property leased hereunder within a period of two (2) years from and after the effective date of this lease shall be grounds for the Lessor, at its option, to terminate this lease and all rights and privileges appertaining hereto.

4.
