WHEREAS, UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY has tendered to COUNTY OF CARBON, State of Wyoming, an agreement covering construction, maintenance and use of a public roadway across the right of way and over the track of the Railroad Company near Hanna, Wyoming; such agreement being identified in the records of the Railroad Company as its C.D. No. 52121-4-9-B; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of said County has said proposed agreement before it and has given it careful review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, it is considered that the best interests of said County will be subserved by the acceptance of said agreement.

Members of the County Planning and Development Board met with the Commissioners to discuss reviewing the current planning regulations.


CURTIS LEE HILTBRUNNER III CLAIM AGAINST COUNTY
