CARBON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE

Frank Smith, Road Supervisor, and Sam Verplanke, Maintenance Supervisor, gave their monthly reports to the Commissioners.

The following Overweight Permit was granted:

Permit #54, Issued February 2, 1982 to Edward Hines Lumber Co., Box 809, Saratoga, Wy., covering ingress or egress to a timber contract over 11 Miles of County Road #101 and 2 Miles of County Road #402, T18,19,20N, R80W, approximately 1 Mile East of Elk Mountain, Wyoming. Permit will expire March 15, 1982.

The following Permit was approved:

Permit #55, dated February 2, 1982 to Northern Natural Gas Co., 7901 Xerxes Ave. S., Minneapolis, Mn., for ingress or egress to a Compressor Station on Willow Road, approximately .5 Miles NE of Highway 287 Intersection, Section 5, T23N, R88W.

SARATOGA LIBRARY

Friends of the Saratoga Library gave a report to the Commissioners to keep the Commissioners informed as to the groups' activities in planning for a new Library in Saratoga. The Carbon County Library Board was also present at the meeting, and the Commissioners asked the Friends of the Saratoga Library to coordinate their efforts and budget requests through the County Library Board

CARBON COUNTY SENIOR SERVICES

Allan Hensala, Mayor of Sinclair, requested partial funding towards the use of a bus to be used to transport Sinclair Senior Citizens to the Rawlins Senior Center on a daily basis. Sinclair will contribute \$2,000.00 a year towards the bus expenses. A motion was made by Lemich, seconded by McMahon and unanimously carried to fund the program. The approximate cost to the County will be \$2,654.00 through June 30, 1982.

CARBON COUNTY LAW LIBRARY

A motion was made by McMahon, seconded by Lemich and unanimously carried to approve a bid by Arrow Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$3,774.00 to construct shelving in the Law Library.

HANNA FIRE DEPARTMENT

A motion was made by McMahon, seconded by Lemich and unanimously carried to approve the purchase of equipment for a two-man dive rescue team in the amount of \$3,600.00.

CARBON COUNTY FAIRBOARD

A motion was made by McMahon, seconded by Lemich and unanimously carried to re-appoint Dick Hiser to the Fairboard for a five year term, beginning February 1, 1982 and ending February 1, 1987.

CARBON COUNTY CHILD DEVELOPMENT

Cissy Whitfield presented a proposal to the Commissioners for financial support in acquiring a new facility for the Carbon County Child Development Center. The cost as presented in the proposal was approximately \$425,000.00. No action was taken.

CARBON COUNTY INDUSTRIAL COUNCIL

Members of the Carbon County Industrial Council gave a report of their activities since forming the Council. Charles Greenhawt of the Council asked the Commissioners to consider adopting a Resolution concerning Industrial Development Revenue Bonding. The Commissioners took the request under advisement.

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSIONER - PROTEST

A motion was made by Lemich, seconded by McMahon and unanimously carried for the Board of County Commissioners to go on record as protesting the present high prices of natural gas in the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming and further protesting the present request by Kansas-Nebraska Natural Gas Company for a rate increase of natural gas prices. It is the feeling of the Commissioners that the residents of Carbon County, especially elderly residents and residents on a fixed income, cannot afford to pay the exorbitant prices being charged for natural gas service. The tremendous amount of past and future increases are causing a severe hardship on all private citizens, as well as governmental entities and it appears that the necessity for rate increases does not come close to outweighing the severe hardships to the customers of Kansas-Nebraska Natural Gas Company in Carbon County.

HANNA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

A motion was made by McMahon and seconded by Grieve to allow \$6,600.00 towards the purchase of a Town of Hanna identification sign to be installed at the turn off to Hanna on U.S. 30. Roll was called with the following results: McMahon, Aye; Grieve, Aye; Lemich, Absent.

CARBON COUNTY PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT - SKYLINE ACRES

The following Case was brought before the Board:

Case #81-13 - Final Plat - Cecil R. Campbell, 419 E. Spruce, Rawlins, Wy. 82301, Final Plat approval of a 50-acre parcel of land to be developed as an Industrial Subdivision, Skyline Acres. The land is located southeast of Rawlins, between Interstate 80 and Old Highway 30, and is legally described as the North 1/2 of Section 24, Township 21 North, Range 87 West, Carbon County, Wyoming.

A motion was made by McMahon and seconded by Grieve to approve Case #81-13. Roll was called with the following results: Grieve, Aye; McMahon, Aye; Lemich, Absent.
