TOWN OF ELK MOUNTAIN

RYAN PARK SNOWMOBILE PARKING AREA

Representatives of the Rawlins Rough Riders Snowmobile Club, the U.S. Forest Service & Earl Seahorn, Contractor for the parking area met with the Commissioners to discuss the fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the bid for the construction of the parking area. Mr. Seahorn requested additional payment for extra fill material hauled onto the site.
