Norman Johnson of Hanna met with the Commissioners to discuss procedure in establishing a Cemetery District for the Hanna area.

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

A motion was made by Lemich, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to declare a vacancy in the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County due to the untimely passing of our beloved associate and friend Martin "Mutt" McMahon. A letter was sent to the Republican Central Committee declaring this vacancy

BAIROIL AMBULANCE

Jon Said of the Bairoil Ambulance met with the Commissioners requesting help in buying a radio for their ambulance, which helps service the northwest part of Carbon County.

A motion was made by Lemich, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to approve payment of \$4,229.00 towards the purchase of the radio.

CARBON COUNTY AMBULANCE

Lon Bromley, Ambulance Director for Carbon County Memorial Hospital requested funds to refurbish an older ambulance and install a radio in it. This ambulance is to be used as a back-up if any other ambulance should break down. The Commissioners granted the money for refurbishment and to install a radio.

ROAD AND BRIDGE

Frank Smith, Road & Bridge Supervisor and Sam Verplancke, Maintenance Supervisor gave their monthly reports to the Commissioners.

The following contract agreement by and between Carbon County Board of Commissioners and McMurry Bros. Co. was signed by the Commissioners.

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

This Agreement made and entered into this 5th day of April 1983, by and between the Carbon County Board of County Commissioners, P. O. Box 6, Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming, as the Owner, and McMurry Brothers Company, P. O. Box 3669, Casper, Natrona County, Wyoming, as the Contractor.

The Contractor agrees to mix approximately nine thousand (9000) tons of asphaltic road mix and stockpile at the Miller Hill Pit located approximately sixteen (16) miles South of Rawlins, Wyoming. The Contractor agrees to furnish weight calculations and tickets to verify quantity stockpiled. The Contractor agrees to haul the required SC800F from the Sinclair Refinery located at Sinclair Wyoming as part of the mixing price of five dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50) per ton.

The Owner agrees to furnish the necessary aggregate and SC800F at no cost to the Contractor, for the asphaltic road mix. The Owner will pay all royalty and pit permits.

The Contractor warrants that he is sufficiently insured to relieve Carbon County of any liability relating to the Contractor's work.

The Contractor agrees to complete this contract no later than June 17th, 1983. The Contractor agrees to clean up all debris, trash and refuse due to his work upon completion of this contract.

The Contractor also agrees to furnish a one hundred (100%) per cent performance bond, if required by the Carbon County Board of County Commissioners.

Progress payments if required will be paid for the quantity produced less five (5%) per cent. Should one payment only be required, the Contractor will be paid ninety five (95%) per cent with the final five (5%) per cent being paid at the end of the advertised period as per State Statutes.

This agreement entered into as of the day, month and year as dated in the first paragraph of this agreement.

OLD STATE PENITENTIARY

Bob Gibson, Rawlins Director for Parks and Recreation presented the board with an update on the old penitentiary. The Wyoming State Building Commission approved \$12,500.00 for a site design on the grounds.

PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

Public Hearing was held before the Board of Commissioners on the following:

Case No. 82-42 - Zone Change - Gary D. Buck, P. O. Box 694, Encampment, WY 82325, zone change from RAM (Ranching, Agriculture, Mining) to RD-10 (Residential Development) to allow for the development of one single-family residence on a 10 acre parcel east of Encampment. Site legally described as part of Lot 10, Section 5, Township 14 North, Range 83 West, Carbon County.

Case No. 82-43 - Zone Change - Richard N. Blake, P. O. Box 133, Encampment, WY 82325, zone change from RAM (Ranching, Agriculture, Mining) to RD-10 (Residential Development) to allow for the development of up to four single-family residences on a 40 acre parcel southeast of Riverside. Site legally described as SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 14 North, Range 83 West, Carbon County.

Case No. 82-46 - Zone Change - Ed & Juanita Richner, Kortes Dam Route, Hanna, WY 82327, zone change from RAM (Ranching, Agriculture, Mining) to RB (Retail Business) to allow for a general store/filling station on a 10 acre parcel located northwest of the Kortes Dam. Site legally described as NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 84 West, Carbon County.

A motion was made by Lemich, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to accept zone change on Case #82-42, #82-43 and #82-46.

DIVE AND RESCUE TEAM

Richard Gregory and Tom Casey from Carbon County - Hanna Dive Rescue Team presented their budget proposal of \$4015.40 for the next fiscal year to the Commissioners.
