FAA AUTOMATED FLIGHT SERVICE STATION

A motion was made by York, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION 1984 - 8

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE SUBMITTAL OF A MODIFIED
PROPOSAL TO LOCATE THE UNITED STATES FAA AUTOMATED
FLIGHT SERVICE STATION AT THE RAWLINS/CARBON COUNTY
AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have previously on the 4th day of January, 1984 endorsed and authorized the submittal of the proposal to locate a United States FAA Automated Flight Service Station at the Rawlins/Carbon County Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming is willing to join with the City of Rawlins in improving financially the proposal by splitting with the City the first year's operational expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming that it endorse and authorize the submittal of a modification of the proposal to locate a United States FAA Automated Flight Service Station at the Rawlins/Carbon County Airport previously submitted, by the addition thereto of a provision providing that Carbon County, Wyoming will agree to pay one-half of the cost of installation of a 200 pair telecommunication line (total estimated cost \$44,078.23, County's share not to exceed \$22,039.12) and forgive the first year's annual rent (total \$32,312.00, county's share \$16,156.00).

CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS, W.S. 22-25-106 - All Candidates whether successful or not, must file a statement of campaign receipts and expenditures by September 21, 1984.

FILING OFFICES, W.S. 22-25-107 - Candidates for municipal, County, judicial, school or college board offices file with the County Clerk. Candidates for state legislative or district judgeship offices file with the County Clerk and Secretary of State. Candidates for statewide offices file with the Secretary of State.

W.S. 22-25-108. - A candidate who fails to file a full and complete itemized statement within the time required is guilty of a misdemeanor and no such candidate shall receive a certificate of nomination or election nor shall he enter upon the duties of the office, and a vacancy shall exist.
