CARBON COUNTY WATER COMMISSIONER

A motion was made by York, seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to execute the following:

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

FOR WATER COMMISSIONER SERVICES

It is hereby mutually agreed and understood that this document shall serve to create and specify the terms of a cooperative contract relationship between the Wyoming State Engineer's Office, hereinafter referred to as the "State", and Carbon County, hereinafter referred to as the "County", and the City of Cheyenne, hereinafter referred to as the "City". Carbon County will be acting on behalf of the other entities which are also participating, and are listed under Item II below.

It is hereby mutually agreed and understood that pursuant to the terms of this agreement, the County, with the approval of the Division Superintendent, will provide the services of a full time, year around, Deputy Water Commissioner in connection with water administration and data collection responsibilities ON THE LITTLE SNAKE, ENCAMPMENT RIVERS AND DOUGLAS CREEK, Water Division No. 1 of the State of Wyoming for the consideration specified herein, with funds received from the City and the State as shown in Item II below.

- I. Duties of this Water Commissioner are as specifically described on the attached sheet and any other related duties as directed by the Superintendent of Water Division No. I.
- II. The State agrees to a financial contribution of \$7,000.00 toward this cooperative effort for the contract period of an estimated total annual cost of \$27,000.00 to be funded and budgeted as follows:

III. Contract time period will be July 1, 1985 through June 30, 1986.

IV. The State will make quarterly payments of its share in advance, commencing July 1, 1985. The County must submit a statement to the State for the first quarter and each subsequent quarter. The second, third, and fourth quarter statements must be accompanied by a printout or other itemization of the previous quarter's expenditures.

V. If at any time during the performance of this contract, in the opinion of either party, the work is not progressing satisfactorily or within the terms of this agreement, then, after written notice, either party may terminate

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this agreement, then, after written notice, either party may terminate this agreement or any parts thereof. At such termination date, the County/State will be entitled to prorata payment for all work accomplished and accepted by the State/County.

JUVENILE PLANNING COMMITTEE

A hearing was held at 2:30 P.M. on all proposals for the expenditure of Juvenile Community Alternative Funds. An application for \$20,000.00 was forwarded to the Division of Public Assistance and Social Services for funding consideration.

CARBON COUNTY CORONER

Zachery Rinderer, County Coroner, Ray Ring, D-Pass Director, and Curtis Rostad met with the Commissioners to establish uniform burial policies for indigent persons who must be buried at public expense. Policies will be drafted by the County Coroner's Office and reviewed by the County Attorney's Office before final adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.

CARBON COUNTY PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

ARAPAHO FLATS SUBDIVISION

A motion was made by York and seconded by Grieve to require Billy Rasberry, developer of the Arapaho Flats Subdivision to respond to the Commissioners by June 18, 1985 concerning the following four options for improvements required for the Subdivision:

- a. To extend the Subdivision agreement from April 30, 1985 to October 15, 1985 and extend the letter of credit until November 15, 1985 and increase the letter of credit from \$3020.00 to \$6000.00
- b. To vacate the plat and to void the RD5 zoning. The twenty (20) acres would then revert back to RAM.
- c. To have the County draw on the current letter of credit to have the County install necessary improvements and to have the County obtain any balance over the amount of the letter of credit from Billy Rasberry by any means necessary.
- d. To have improvements as agreed to completed by July 5, 1985.

Roll was called with the following results: Grieve, aye; York, aye; Daily, absent.
