RESOLUTION 1985-7

APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of May, 1985, Mary G. Bradford, Carbon County Clerk, the budget making authority, prepared and submitted to the Board a county budget for the 1985-86 fiscal year ending June 30, 1986.

WHEREAS, such a budget was duly entered at large upon the records of this Board and a copy thereof was made available for public inspection at the office of the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on such budget, together with the summary of said budget, was published in the Rawlins Daily Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the county on the 28th day of June, 1985 and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on such budget at the time and place specified in said notice, at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, following such public hearing certain alterations and revisions were made in such proposed budget, all of which more fully appear in the minutes of this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the county budget, as so revised and altered, be adopted as the official county budget for the 1985-86 fiscal year ending June 30, 1986.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following appropriations be made for the 1985-86 fiscal year ending June 30, 1986 and that the expenditures of each officer, department or spending agency be limited to the amount herein appropriated.




