CARBON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE

A motion was made by Daily and seconded by Grieve, and unanimously carried to enter into a Right of Way Agreement between Carbon County and Robert Corpening over and across the following described lands located in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming:

A parcel of land located in the N½ of Section 33, Township 17 North, Range 82 West, of the 6th P.M., Carbon County, Wyoming; being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point S75°59'22"E, 5386.56' from the NW Corner of Section 32, T17N, R82W, which point is S00°32'00"E, 1329.93' from the assumed location of the NW Corner of said Section 33, which corner has been lost or destroyed. Thence N1°08'28"E, 30.00' to the true point of beginning, thence N1°08'28"E, 20.00', thence S88°51'32"E, 2901.80', thence through a curve to the right with a radius of 3397.18' and a central angle of 8°53'00", a distance of 526.71', thence S79°58'32"E, 10.00', thence S10°01'28"W, 20.00', thence N79°58'32"E, 10.00', thence through a curve to the left with a radius 3377.18' and a central angle of 8°53'00", a distance 533.59', thence N88°51'32"E, 2901.80', to the true point of beginning. The above described parcel of land contains 1.58 acres more or less. All bearings are referenced to G. L. O. recorded bearings.

Lease is on record in the office of the County Clerk.

RESOLUTION 1985 - 10

WHEREAS Carbon County, Wyoming is a socially and economically impacted county attributable in part to coal and coal related development, and

WHEREAS, Carbon County has great need of a heavy equipment and vehicle maintenance facility, and the Wyoming Farm Loan Board administers various grant programs from which funds may be available for such projects;

THEREFORE, be it resolved, that Carbon County file an application to the Wyoming Farm Loan Board requesting a grant to partially finance the construction of a heavy equipment and vehicle maintenance facility.

COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT

A motion was made by Daily and seconded by Grieve to enter into Contract No. 85-0367 whereby the Wyoming Department of Health and Social Services will purchase services from the Carbon County Commission:

- A. Emergency medical services for low-income families.
- B. Emergency "food basket" program for low-income families.

The contract is effective October 1, 1985 to September 30, 1986.

DAMAGE CLAIM

CARBON COUNTY PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

SARATOGA - PLATTE VALLEY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

A motion was made by Daily, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to approve \$4,500.00 for expenditures to be made for it's campaign of winter promotions.

AMOCO BAIROIL PROJECT

Representatives of Amoco met with the Commissioners in regard to the impact the plant will have on Carbon County. County employment, revenue and expenditure projections were presented to the Commissioners based on studies done because of the project.

CARBON COUNTY SENIOR SERVICES

The Commissioners accepted with regret the resignation of Jean Short from the Senior Services Board.


