BAGGS SOLID WASTE BOARD

A motion was made by Daily, seconded by York and unanimously carried to accept with regret the resignation of Charlotte Corson from the Baggs Solid Waste Board.

A motion was made by York, seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to appoint Margaret M. Nixon to the unexpired term of Charlotte Corson, beginning April 15, 1986 and ending September 4, 1988.

DIXON AIRPORT BOARD

A motion was made by Daily, seconded by York and unanimously carried to reappoint Steve Page to the Dixon Airport Board for a five year term, beginning February 3, 1986 and ending February 4, 1991.

LITTLE SNAKE RIVER VALLEY LIBRARY

A motion was made by Daily, seconded by York and unanimously carried to call for bids for the construction of the Little Snake River Valley Library.

Roll was called with the following results: Grieve, aye; York, aye; Daily, aye.

CARBON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE

A motion was made by York, seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to make application to the Farm Loan Board for a \$876,408.00 grant for reconstruction and upgrading Carbon County Road 401, beginning approximately twenty-six (26) miles south of Rawlins and ending at the National Forest boundary and a twelve (12) mile section of Carbon County Road 500 beginning at its intersection with Carbon County Road 401 and ending at Jack Creek.

PICK BRIDGE

Reba Massey, representative of the State Historic Preservation office asked the Commissioners to leave the Pick Bridge intact and not remove decking or supports from the bridge. The Commissioners had asked \$22,000.00 reimbursement from the Wyoming Highway Department to leave these materials in place.

The request to leave the materials on the bridge at no cost to the Wyoming Highway Department was taken under advisement.

FIREWORKS

Rodger McDaniel representing Don Haddenham of Cheyenne, requested a review of the Carbon County Firework Resolution with the suggestion that it be amended to allow the sale and use of fireworks. Mr. McDaniel presented the Resolution of Laramie County to the Commissioners. This Resolution allows the sale and use of fireworks.

A motion was made by Daily to direct the County Attorney to prepare a draft for an amended Resolution. The motion died for the lack of a second.

LEASE OF COUNTY PROPERTY

A motion was made by York, seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to execute a lease between the Board of County Commissioners and Floyd E. and Josephine M. Roberson for Lot 3, Block 59, Original Town of Riverside, Carbon County, Wyoming. The lease is on record in the office of the County Clerk.


HANNA RECREATION

The Hanna Joint Powers Board requested funds to continue the operation of the Hanna Recreation Center. The Commissioners took the request under advisement.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, the meeting was adjourned.
