CARBON COUNTY SENIOR SERVICES

Ted Prosen submitted his resignation from the Senior Services Board and Wilma Cook passed away in June, 1988. It is with regret that the Senior Board has lost these members.

A motion was made by Daily and seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to appoint Walt Rasmussen to fill the unexpired term of Ted Prosen beginning October 4, 1988 and ending March 1, 1990; and Nancy Pennock to fill the unexpired term of Wilma Cook beginning October 4, 1988 and ending March 1, 1990.

CARBON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE

A motion was made by Graalman and seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to accept \$5,000.00 from Edward Ledder to help replace a bridge on CR320 across the Medicine Bow River. The bridge will be a Carbon County bridge designed and built by the County.

COUNTY INSURANCE

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to seperate the General Liability portion from U.S.F.&G. and put with the Penco Plan, terminate the United Fire Public Official Liability and put these coverages with the Penco Plan, add Wyoming Law Enforcement to the Penco Plan and finally purchase extended reporting period coverage for three years on cancellation of the United Fire Public Official Policy.

PERSONNEL MATTERS

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to adjourn for an executive session relating to personnel matters.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, the meeting was adjourned.
