HANNA RECREATION CENTER

Jeff Barnett made a request of \$50,000.00 for the Hanna Recreation Center budget. The Commissioners took the request under advisement.

CARBON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE

A motion was made by Daily, seonded by Graalman and unanimously carried to approve the expenditure of \$300,000.00 to \$350,000.00 of Farm to Market Money on sections of four roads including County Roads 603, 504, 3 and 291.

A motion was made by Daily, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to approve \$12,000.00 for the purchase of computer hardware and software to be used in the Road & Bridge department.

CARBON COUNTY MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

A motion was made by Daily, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to adopt the following:

R E S O L U T I O N     1 9 8 8 - 3

A RESOLUTION, OF THE CARBON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND THE MEMORIAL HOSPITAL OF CARBON COUNTY BOARD OF TRUST-TEES, JOINTLY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING FARM LOAN BOARD FOR FUNDS TO ASSIST IN THE RENOVATION AND UPGRADING OF THE FACILITIES AT THE MEMORIAL HOSPITAL OF CARBON COUNTY IN RAWLINS, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, the Memorial Hospital of Carbon County Board of Trustees, in cooperation with the Carbon County Board of Commissioners, has already spent in excess of \$4 million to upgrade portions of the hospital facilities; and,

WHEREAS, additional renovations are needed to bring the hospital into compliance with fire, building & electrical codes, and thereby make the facility safer for the general public; and,

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to upgrade the hospital facilities so as to meet the growing local need for additional operating room space and surgical demand; and,

WHEREAS, the renovation and upgrading of the hospital facilities do not conflict with the Rawlins or the Carbon County comprehensive plans, but does comply with the plans by assuring that the public facility will be able to meet future demands and needs; and,

WHEREAS, the Wyoming Farm Loan Board's Government Royalty Impact Assistance Account has been designated to assist communities which have been impacted by the production of minerals; and,

WHEREAS, Rawlins and Carbon County have been both positively and negatively impacted by mineral production over the years, is currently economically depressed due to the depressed state of the mineral industry, and no longer has the available funds to address the capital improvement needs of the local hospital;

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THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Carbon County Board of Commissioners and the Memorial Hospital of Carbon County Board of Trustees, that the authorization is given for the submittal of a grant application to the Wyoming Farm Loan Board for the purpose of obtaining \$1,217,005.00 from the Government Royalty Impact Assistance Account, to assist in the renovation and upgrading of the Memorial Hospital of Carbon County in Rawlins, Wyoming.


