EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Nick Casson, Carbon County Emergency Coordinator, reported on emergency services through

RAWLINS OVERLOOK

Scott Thomas requested the Board have County personnel analyze the possibility of constructing a road to the proposed Rawlins Overlook.

OLD PENITENTIARY JOINT POWERS BOARD

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to appoint Roger Vagner to a three year term on the Old Penitentiary Joint Power Board beginning 5/16/89 and ending 5/3/92.

COUNTY COURT

County Court Judge, Ken Stebner met with the Commissioners to discuss the possibility of additional shelving for use by County Court. The request will be assigned to County Building & Grounds Supervisor, Bud Greene.

JUVENILE COMMUNITY ALTERNATIVES

Marianne Lee, D-PASS representative presented two applications for the Board's consideration to receive Juvenile Community Alternatives funding.support. The applications were from Big Brothers/Big Sisters and K.I.D.S.,Inc.

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille and carried to support the application of K.I.D.S., Inc. for the Juvenile Community Alternatives funding through the State of Wyoming.

ROAD & BRIDGE

After reviewing the fuel bids opened at the May 2, 1989 meeting, a motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille and carried to accept the bid of Seiloff Oil Company for unleaded gasoline and #1 & #2 diesel fuel.

Don Neuman, County Road Construction Supervisor informed the Board that all six shops in Carbon County have completed the annual health and safety training under the EVTAP and CORE requirements for exemption.program.

Neuman updated the Commissioners on road damage claims between the County and the City of Rawlins on County Road 401. The damage occured as a result of the construction of the City's pipeline.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Dan Schinkle, County Fire Warden requested permission to repair water pumps on the County fire trucks at an estimated cost of \$8,000.00. The repairs were allowed.

SARATOGA AMBULANCE

Don Herold, representing the Saratoga Ambulance group requested \$7,500.00 from the fiscal year 1989-90 budget. The request was taken under advisement.

AUDIT

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille and passed to authorize Chairman, O. R. "Bud" Daily to enter into a contract with Wyoming Royalties, Inc. to conduct a mineral royalty audit for Carbon County at the direction of the County Attorney.
