A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille and passed to appoint Dale Wille to the Baggs Solid Waste Disposal District to fill the unexpired term of Thomas W. Shepard beginning October 3, 1989 and ending September 4, 1991.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille to proclaim the month of October 1989 as Domestic Violence Awareness Month and October 16, 1989 as National Day of Unity and urge all citizens to actively participate in the scheduled activities and programs sponsored by Citizens Organized to see Violence Ended, Inc. (C.O.V.E.) and to work towards the elimination of personal and institutional violence against women.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

Nick Casson, Emergency Management Agency Coordinator reported on his meeting with the Civil Defense people; the county scored high. Casson requested funds to purchase a computer, the state would pay half the cost. No action was taken on the request.

INSURANCE

C.B.S. Insurance Consultants' representative, Scott Benasek presented specifications for the various county property and liability insurance coverages for the purpose of letting bids. The Commissioners accepted the specifications as presented and will advertise a call for bids.

PLANNING

Bob Konrath, representing the Planning Commission reported on the activities of that group.

A motion was made by Wille to approve Case File No. 89-06, the motion was seconded by Graalman.

Case File No. 89-06 - Zone Change - Lexine Davis, P. O. Box 362, Baggs, WY 82321. A zone change from RAM (Ranching, Agriculture, Mining) to HB (Highway Business) to allow for a motel and cafe to be located on 7 acres of land legally described as in the E½E½SW¼NE½ of Section 5, Township 12 North, Range 91 West, Carbon County, Wyoming.

Roll was called with the following results: Daily, aye; Graalman, aye; Wille, aye.

PLAY AND LEARNING CENTER, SARATOGA

Donna Erickson, representing the Play and Learning Center in Saratoga, requested an additional \$1,000.00 funding. A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille and unanimously carried to allow the funding.

ROAD AND BRIDGE

Office Manager, Patricia Schuler asked that the Road & Bridge suite of offices be used only for County office space. The Board agreed.

Don Neuman, supervisor for Road & Bridge reported on current activities of that department; discussion included the Sinclair truck route and 4 mile road around Baggs.

A bid opening for the seeding of the south road (C.C.R. #401) right of way was held at 3:00 p.m. The following bids were received:
