## BUREAU OF RECLAMATION

Wade Waldrup, Carbon County Civil Attorney met with the Board to discuss right-of-ways on Carbon County roads.

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to execute a right-of-way easement from Joe Glode, Leonard Johnson and John Johnson to the County of Carbon. A copy of the easement is on file in the office of the County Clerk.

Susan Grafton, County Planner gave an update on the proposed tourist information center.

Also, a report on estimated costs for the rural addressing system were presented.
