PUBLIC HEALTH

Public Health nurse, Sherrie Patch talked about raising the Saratoga employee \$50.00 more a month and increasing the work schedule four hours a month. Also discussed was the replacement of Mrs. Sjogren with Mrs. Welcher for the prenatal services.

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to enter into a purchase contract for professional nursing service with the Nursing Services, Wyoming State Division of Health & Medical Services and Karen Welcher L.P.N. for the teaching of group prenatal classes.

PLANNING

County Planner, Susan Grafton gave her monthly report and updated the Commissioners on the ongoing projects.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Gene McMillan and Susan Grafton of the Carbon County Economic Development Corporation, reported on the progress of the new penitentiary project and other projects.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

County Fire Warden, Dan Schinkle talked about forming a Fire District. Schinkle has some people that would like to talk to the Commissioners concerning the fire districting possibility.

Schinkle wants to make some rules for fire protection for out in the County, like at Seminoe Boat Club.

ROAD & BRIDGE

County Road & Bridge supervisor, Don Neuman and office manager Patty Schuler, had the Commissioners sign letters to Pete Melia and Mrs. Don O'Brien with F.A.A. Denver Airport District Office about Shively Filed near Saratoga, to Vern J. Fauss with U. S. Bureau of Reclamation Missouri Basin Region about Carbon County Road #351 - Seminoe Road, and to Tony Gonzales about his job position located in the Medicine Bow District.

Neuman talked about the letters from Joseph F. Yovich, District Engineer Wyoming State Highway Department concerning County Road #401 and the SC-CFM program. Also discussed was a letter from Don G. Carroll, District Ranger with the Forest Service concerning Ryan Park.
