AUDIT

Representatives of McGladrey & Pullen, Connie Brezik and Dennise Yennie presented the preliminary draft of the audit for fiscal year 1988-89. Also discussed were the management letter, an audit of the self-insurance plan and central purchasing.

SPECIAL AUDIT COMMITTEE

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to have the Special Audit Committee address the financial and administrative matters recommended by McGladrey & Pullen in the audit report and management letter for fiscal year 1988-89.

BIG BROTHERS, BIG SISTERS.

Tom Campbell, representing Big Brothers, Big Sisters notified the Board that the local organization is losing the support of the national Big Brother, Big Sisters. K.I.D.S. Inc. is planning to continue the program. The local Big Brothers, Big Sisters group would like their remaining county allocation to be paid to K.I.D.S to continue the program.

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to allow the remaining allocation for Big Brothers, Big Sisters in the fiscal year 1989-90 budget to be paid to K.I.D.S., Inc. who will continue the program.

JACK CREEK ROAD

John Deblaker appeared before the Board to express his feelings regarding the moving of the Jack Creek Road. He objects to the dust and other problems the proposed road would cause. He is also opposed to changes the Saratoga Airport wants to make. He would like the road to go back to Bridge Street where it was to start with.

Mr. Davidson from Saratoga also appeared before the Board. He is against moving the road, because of the flooding and dust it will cause. He thinks it will cost the County too much.

Mrs. Vargas appeared before the Board. She expressed her concerns regarding dust and snow problems if the Jack Creek Road is moved. She presented a letter from other Saratoga people.

Commissioner, Wille announced that the County had made no decision on the Saratoga (Jack Creek Road).
