Engstrom also discussed the possibilities of buying a used main frame computer.

County Attorney, Tom Campbell discussed a water and sewer district for Ryan Park. Campbell has some concerns he will address with Ryan Park by letter.

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and unanimously carried to waive the bond for this election.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Dan Brownell discussed budget cuts in the Wyoming Department of Commerce/Division of Parks and Cultural Resources/State Parks and Historic Sites.

AUDIT

Denise Yennie of McGladry & Pullen met with representatives of various County offices and boards to discuss the audit of fiscal year 1990-91.

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to not encumber salaries and utilities.

COMPUTER

PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

County Planner, Nina Adams gave her administrator's report for February, 1992. Adams also presented the 1991 Annual Planning Report.

K.I.D.S. GRANT

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to sign a contract with the City of Rawlins for administration of the K.I.D.S. Grant (building construction).

SENIOR SERVICES BOARD

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to appoint Blanche McNamara from Rawlins to the Senior Services Board for a three year term, and appoint A. D. Jones of Baggs to the Senior Services Board for a three year term.

ROAD & BRIDGE

County Road & Bridge Supervisor Don Neuman and Lowell Fleenor of the Wyoming Department of Transportation discussed SC-CFM monies. Fleenor also presented the Commissioners with a \$92,935.15 state warrant to help with flood damage on the Seminoe Road.

WILDLAND FIRE CONTROL

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to sign a Wildland Fire Control Annual Operating Plan.

MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR FIRE PROTECTION

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and carried to sign a Mutual Aid Agreement for Fire Protection.

ROAD & BRIDGE

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and unanimously carried to approve the purchase of a new Caterpillar CS563 vibratory compactor at a cost of \$44,000.00.
