#### LITIGATION

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and carried to deny the claim against Carbon County filed by the attorney for Marcy Craig based not exclusively on the following reasons: 1. fail to state a claim 2. not within the scope of employment.

#### COUNTY RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSES

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to offer county restaurant liquor licenses for the fee of \$500.00 per year.

#### PUBLIC HEALTH

The Commissioners signed an agreement for professional/consultant services between the Wyoming Department of Health, Division of Preventive Medicine and Carbon County Community Nursing Service.

The Commissioners signed a grant agreement between the Wyoming Department of Health, Division of Public Health and Carbon County Public Health Nursing.

#### ROAD & BRIDGE

The Commissioners signed an annual operating plan agreement between Carbon County, Wyoming, the State Forestry Division, the U.S.D.A. Forest Service and the U.S.D.I. Bureau of Land Management.

The Commissioners signed a letter to Dave Campbell of Sinclair Pipeline about lowering two lines north of Sinclair on the Seminoe Road, County Road #351.
