DISCRETIONARY FUNDS

Applications were received by the Commissioners for Community Service Block Grant Discretionary Funds. The Board gave its support to Western Wyoming Family Planning (\$1,500.00) and Carbon County Public Health Nursing (\$20,000.00) for their applications to the State of Wyoming Department of Health.

JAIL

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and unanimously carried to accept the bid of \$6,625.80 from L & L Electric to repair and install exhaust fans in the jail.

JOINT POWERS BOARD OF CARBON COUNTY - TOWN OF SARATOGA

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to appoint Jame A. Larscheid to the Joint Powers Board of Carbon County - Town of Saratoga for a three year term.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

County Fire Warden, Dwight France, would like to see if there is a way to enter into a mutual aid agreement between Albany County and Carbon County.

RYAN PARK

Mr. & Mrs. Patchen of Ryan Park need to have the support of a governmental entity to apply for a grant to build a fire building. No action was taken.

HOMELESS

Jolene Lanka expressed her desire to start a safe haven house for the homeless. No action was taken by the board.


LIBRARY
