



CALL BEFORE YOU BURN

Before conducting any type of open burning here in Carbon County, it is highly requested that you call your local dispatch center and notify them of the location, date, time and a contact number for the person conducting the burn. If you are requesting to burn any materials not considered natural, i.e. tree limbs, slash piles, grass/shrubs, etc. special permitting may be required in addition through the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality.

You will not need to call in for normal burning of household refuse if it is being disposed of in an incinerator or barrel not larger than a 55-gallon container. However, it is highly advised that the area around the container be free of combustible materials, fuels, and vegetation and have a mesh or screen like material to act as a spark arrestor placed on top of the container.
